WCD III/SeaKing 2A Allocation Agreement 2020 – 2022

This agreement was negotiated by representatives from the 2A schools in South Puget Sound League (SPSL), Olympic League (OLY), and KingCo Conference. The agreement includes the following:

- 16-entry modified bracket for most sports
- In a 16-team tournament, the following allocations will be given: SPSL 2A – 5; OLY – 4; KingCo- 4
 - The three (3) league champions (or #1 league seed as determined by the league) will be the top three seeds on the Bi-District bracket. The order for seeds 1-3 will be determined by a Seeding Committee. Remaining league allocations (SPSL 4, OLY- 3, KingCo- 3), plus three (3) at large (wildcard) allocations will be determined by a Seeding Committee.
 - Seeding Committee Selection process and data points/tools that the committee will use to seed teams will be included in a separate document.
- In football, if 5 seeds to state:
 - SPSL 3, OLY 2, KING 2.
 - The three (3) league champions (or #1 league seed as determined by the league) will be the top three seeds on the Bi-District bracket. The order for seeds 1-3 will be determined by a Seeding Committee. Remaining league allocations (SPSL 2, OLY- 1, KingCo- 1), plus three (3) at large (wildcard) allocations will be determined by a Seeding Committee as well.
- In football, if 6 seeds to state:
 - SPSL 4, OLY 3, KING 3
 - The three (3) league champions (or #1 league seed as determined by the league) will be the top three seeds on the Bi-District bracket. The order for seeds 1-3 will be determined by a Seeding Committee. Remaining league allocations (SPSL 3, OLY- 2, KingCo- 2), plus two (2) at large (wildcard) allocations will be determined by a Seeding Committee as well.

Schools in the 2A classification in the West Central District III (WCDIII)/SeaKing project to have either five (5) or six (6) allocations to state in the next two-year cycle. "Final" allocations come out after the first three weeks of the fall sports season and two weeks later in the winter and spring.

Brackets: (to be posted on the District websites)

1. 2A 16-team entry modified bracket
 - To be used for: baseball, basketball, softball, tennis, volleyball and soccer
2. 2A Football bracket (6 allocations)
3. 2A Football bracket (5 allocations)

Fall

- **Cross Country –**
 - Allocations:
 - Teams: SPSL – 6; OLY - 5; KingCo- 5
 - Individuals: SPSL – 42; OLY - 35; KingCo 35
- **Football –**
 - Each home team is listed on the bottom of the bracket.
 - Sites (WCD/SeaKing approved) will be predetermined by the leagues included in this agreement.
 - If a mid-week playoff game is played by either league, teams involved are not to play until Saturday.
 - Artificial Turf is required UNLESS there isn't an artificial turf field near the host school. In this case the host school can make a written request (with rationale) to both District Directors for a waiver to be granted. The District Directors review the waiver, visit the site and make a ruling no later than three (3) days prior to the contest.
 - The League hosting the game will share revenue for games 4-5-6. League hosting games 1-2-3 keeping gate.
- **Girls Soccer -**
 - Same bracket if 5 or 6 allocations to state
 - Home team is listed on the bottom of the bracket

- Game 15 winner and game 16 winner flip for 5th and 6th seeds (Game must be played if the 6th seed does not advance)
- Field Turf required
- **Girls Swim/Dive**
 - Entries into the bi-district meet are earned through bettering posted qualifying standards.
 - Bi-district meet will be hosted at Hazen High School.
- **Boys and Girls Golf**
 - Site: Gold Mountain In Bremerton
 - Schools to billed by the WCDIII per participant. SeaKing District receives the bill for KingCo schools.
 - Allocations: TBA
 - By WCDIII formula
 - Top two-thirds of state allocation go directly to state from league (s)
 - Remaining third X 3 qualify (approx. 20-25) to the WCDIII/SeaKing tourney in May for the balance of allocations to state.
- **Boys Tennis**
 - Investigating sites: Bremerton, Boeing, and other possibilities (PLU, Sprinker, etc.) for the next 2-year scheduling cycle. League Commissioners will continue this work and report back on possibilities.
 - Allocations: SPSL- 6; OLY - 5; KingCo- 5
- **Volleyball**
 - **Host sites: Will be listed in the District Syllabus along with the final bracket. (Sammamish is a willing host)**
 - Allocations: SPSL- 5; OLY - 4; KingCo- 4 plus three (3) at large (wildcard) allocations

Winter

- **Basketball**
 - Sites determined by District Basketball Committees.
 - Allocations: SPSL- 5; OLY - 4; KingCo- 4 plus three (3) at large (wildcard) allocations
- **Boys Swim/Dive**
 - Entries into the bi-district meet are earned through bettering posted qualifying standards.
 - Bi-district meet will be hosted at Hazen High School.
- **Boys/Girls Wrestling -**
 - TBD based on regional draw
- **Gymnastics-** We will remain separated. 2A = 21 WIAA team entry tournament / D-2 = 6 teams / D-3 = 6 teams and will look at separate district championship events to advance to WIAA State.

Spring

- **Baseball-**
 - Site/Sites: **The Fairgrounds in Silverdale.**
 - If rainouts through first Sunday of the tournament, modified bracket will be substituted.
 - If rainouts through the second weekend, the Seeding Committee will determine seeds of each league's allotment of teams.
 - Allocations: SPSL- 5; OLY - 4; KingCo- 4 plus three (3) at large (wildcard) allocations
- **Softball (Fastpitch)**
 - Site/Sites: **The RAC in Olympia.**
 - If rainouts through first Sunday of the tournament, modified bracket will be substituted.
 - If rainouts through the second weekend, the Seeding Committee will determine seeds of each league's allotment of teams.
 - Allocations: SPSL- 5; OLY - 4; KingCo- 4 plus three (3) at large (wildcard) allocations

- **Boys Soccer**
 - Same bracket if 5 or 6 allocations to state
 - Home team is listed on the bottom of the bracket
 - Game 15 winner and game 16 winner flip for 5th and 6th seeds (Game must be played if the 6th seed does not advance)
 - Field Turf required
 - Allocations: SPSL – 5; OLY - 4; KingCo- 4 plus three (3) at large (wildcard) allocations

- **Girls Tennis**
 - Investigating sites: Bremerton, Boeing, and other possibilities (PLU, Sprinker, etc.) for the next 2-year scheduling cycle. League Commissioners will continue this work and report back on possibilities.
 - Allocations: SPSL – 6; OLY - 5; KingCo- 5

- **Track**
 - Site: Renton Stadium for the next two years (20-21, 21-22). North Mason for the following two years (22-23, 23-24).
 - Allocations: SPSL – 6; OLY - 5; KingCo- 5

GENERAL INFO

- **Reminder:** Final Allocations are not determined until after the third week of each season and are subject to approval of the WIAA Executive Board.
- Financial arrangements as follows:
 - Football / Week 10 – League hosting game assumes revenue share on games 4-5-6. League hosting games 1-2-3 keeping gate.
 - Golf and Tennis – SeaKing will pay for SeaKing Schools. WCDIII will bill their schools per participant.
 - Remaining Sports- West Central District 3 / SeaKing District 2 will split all profit/loss.
 - The split between districts will be based on the percentage of teams from each district in the tournament (e.g. If SPSL has 6 berths, the Olympic League has 5 berths, and KingCo 5 berths then the WCDIII picks up 11/16 or 69% of the profit/loss and SeaKing will pick up 5/16 or 31% of the profit/loss .
- Passes **not** accepted (includes Leagues, School Districts, and State Passes). Exceptions:
 - WCD/SeaKing Lifetime Passes
 - WSCA (Washington State Coaches Association)
 - WSSAAA (Washington Secondary School Athletic Administrators Association)
 - School Board Members, Superintendent who are added to a tournament's pass list
 - Supervisors according to Tournament Guidelines
- Admission Prices:
 - All Sports/Activities
 - Adults- \$8, Students without ASB
 - Students with ASB & Senior Citizens- \$5
 - Elementary/Children- \$4
- Officials scheduled with host site Assigning Officials Secretary.
- The District Directors or designee and League Contacts will authorize Game/Match/Meet schedule changes.
- It is recommended that each league have a designated commissioner, for each sport. This commissioner is to attend WCD/SeaKing sport specific meeting(s).
- Soccer and Football games will be played on approved artificial surface field unless and appeal is granted by both District Directors.
- Roster sizes will be according to State Tournament Guidelines.
- Game balls will be designated the same for all schools in the District Tournament Guidelines and then provided by the home team. District 2 schools follow the WIAA guidelines for balls.

*This agreement will be reviewed after one year (Spring 2021) and adjusted if agreed upon by the three Leagues.
