Post Season Agreement

2018 - 2020

This agreement is made between the Olympic League 1A schools (Chimacum HS, Klahowya HS, Port Townsend HS) and the Nisqually League schools (Annie Wright, Bellevue Christian, Cascade Christian, Charles Wright Academy, Seattle Christian, Vashon HS) for the 2018-2020 allocation cycle.

District Tournaments will follow specific bracket formats based on Boys or Girls Sports and on whether there are 2 or 3 allocations to the State Tournament. Sample brackets for 2 allocations for Boys and Girls sports are attached. Number of seeds and brackets can change dependent on the number of schools fielding teams (or not) in specific sports.

Fall Sports

Cross Country – Each School within the District will send all of their teams to the Westside Classic at Chambers Bay Golf Course on Saturday, November 2, 2019.

Football – The Olympic and Nisqually Leagues have combined into one league. Therefore, post-season representation will be based on the final league standings of the six game league schedule.

- Any ties will be broke according to league guidelines/SOPS that have been adopted by schools.

Girls Soccer – This tournament will be based on modified double elimination tournament. Game 1 will be single elimination.

- In 2019, the top two teams from the Olympic and top three teams from the Nisqually League will play for two berths into the WIAA 1A State tournament.
 - Format: See 1A WCD Boys Bracket (2 allocations) Due to only having 5 N.L. teams in 2019
 - Dates:
 - Game 1- Saturday, November 2 - O2 @ N3 (District approved site), loser out
 - Games 2 & 3 – Tuesday, November 5 @ approved site (Oly.-2018, Nisq.-2019); Winners to Gm5, losers to Gm4
 - Games 4 & 5 – Thursday, November 7; (Winner G4 to G6, loser out; Winner G5 #1 seed, loser to G6) @ approved site
 - Game 6 – Saturday, November 9, winner #2 seed, loser out @ approved site

Volleyball – This tournament will be based on the agreed upon Modified double elimination tournament. The first two rounds (Game 1 & 2) will be single elimination.

- The top two teams from the Olympic and top four teams from the Nisqually League will play for two berths into the WIAA 1A State tournament.
 - Format: 2 Allocation Bracket – See WCD 1A Girls Bracket (2 Allocation)
 - Dates:
 - Game 1 – Tuesday, November 5 - O2 @ N4, loser out
 - Game 2 – Thursday, November 7 - Winner Gm#1 @ N3, loser out
 - Games 3 through 7– Saturday, November 9 @approved site
 - Host: 2018 – Nisq. League 2019 – Olympic league

Boys Tennis – Tournament will be based on an eight entry modified double elimination tournament for both singles and doubles teams. Nisq. will send their top five singles & Oly will send their top three. Same for doubles teams.(NL-5/OL-3). Numbers can change depending on the number of schools fielding teams.

- Date: October 30-31, 2019
 - Wednesday, 10/30 - 3pm – 7pm
 - Thursday, 10/31 - 8:00am – 5pm
 - Numbers can change dependent on # of teams
- Site: Sprinker (Spanaway)
- \$25.00 per team entry will be charged the school in which participants come from.
- Berths to WIAA State Tournament will be determined in the Spring by WIAA.

WINTER SPORTS

Girls Basketball

This tournament will be based on the agreed upon Modified double elimination tournament.

The first round games (Game 1 & 2) will be single elimination.

- The top two teams from the Olympic and four Nisqually League will play for two berths into the WIAA 1A State tournament.
- - Format: Modified double elimination (refer to Girls WCD 1A Bracket-2 Allocations)
 - 2020
 - Game 1: Thurs., 2/13 – O2 @ N4
 - Game 2: Sat., 2/15 – Winner Gm1 @ N3
 - Games 3 & 4: Tues., 2/18 @ D3 approved site; Winners to Gm5, losers to Gm4
 - Games 5 & 6: Thurs., 2/20 - Gm 5 (Winner to Gm 7, loser out); Gm 6 (Winner #1 seed, loser to Gm7) @ D3 approved site
 - Game 7: Sat., 2/22 - Gm 7 (winner #2 seed, loser out) @ D3 approved site
 - If a 3 Allocation Bracket is required for Girls BB
 - Game 7 is not be played- Loser of Gm.6- #2 to State: Winner Gm5 - #3 to State

2020 - Game 1 – O2 @ N4 (rotate home team in 1st round game)

- The rest of the tournament will be the same

Boys Basketball

This tournament will be based on the agreed upon Modified double elimination tournament.

The first round game (Game 1) will be single elimination.

- The top two teams from the Olympic and three Nisqually League will play for two berths into the WIAA 1A State tournament.
- Format: Modified double elimination (refer to Boys WCD 1A Bracket-2 Allocations)
- 2020:
 - Game 1: Sat., 2/15 – O2 @ N3
 - Games 2 & 3: Mon., 2/17 @ D3 approved site; Winners to Gm5, losers to Gm4
 - Games 4 & 5: Wed., 2/19 - Gm 4 (winner to Gm 6 loser out); Gm 5 (Winner #1 seed & loser to Gm6) @ D3 approved site
 - Game 6: Sat., 2/22 game 6 (Winner #2 seed, loser out) @ D3 approved site
- Important items to Remember:
- **WCD3 BB Committee will finalize dates and locations**
 - – Deadline for program pictures, rosters and initial stats and season results
 - – WCD AD meeting to distribute passes and neutral site materials.
 - – Final day to determine and report 1A seeds, and 1A program stats and season results.

Wrestling - Each team will have the opportunity to enter their top two athletes at each weight classification. Please bring all appropriate documentation from the season to assist with proper seeding.

- Seeding to the sub-regional tournament will occur in the following way:
 - CRITERIA FOR SEEDING VARSITY WRESTLERS
 - Best record against district opponents (NL and OL 1A teams) considering ... most wins 1st ... least losses 2nd and then head-to-head.
 - If head-to-head didn't occur or is tied, then common opponent record would be considered next.
 - Coaches vote (In extenuating circumstances, coaches vote will supersede A and B)
 - Coin flip
 - CRITERIA FOR SEEDING JV WRESTLERS
 - JV Wrestlers with winning varsity record will be seeded opposite their varsity wrestler (separate same schools) and then random draw.

Please place your athletes appropriately as any changes in weight classifications will require approval (vote) of the tournament committee after they are seeded into the tournament at the seeding meeting.

- Date: Saturday, February 8, 2020 @ Vashon High School or KSS (depending on Regional host assignments)

SPRING SPORTS

Boys Soccer – This tournament will be based on the agreed upon Modified double elimination tournament. The first round game (Game 1) will be single elimination.

- WCD 1A Boys Bracket – 2 allocations
 - Game 1: Saturday, May 9 - O3 @ O2 District Approved Site, loser out
 - Games 2 & 3: Tuesday, May 12 @ Higher Seeds, winners to Gm5, losers to Gm4
 - Games 4 & 5: Thursday, May 14 @ D3 approved site; (Winner Gm4 to Gm6, loser out; Winner Gm5 - #1 seed, loser to Gm6)
 - Game 6: Saturday, May 16 @ D3 approved neutral site; (Winner #2 seed, loser out)
 - Host: 2019 – Nisqually League / 2020 – Olympic League

Baseball – This tournament will be based on the agreed upon Modified double elimination tournament. The first round (Game 1) will be single elimination.

- 2020 – The top 2 teams from the Olympic and top three from Nisqually will play for two berths into the WIAA 1A State tournament.
 - Format: Modified double elimination (WCD 1A Boys brackets - 2 allocations)
 - Host: 2019 – Nisqually League / 2020 – Olympic League
 - Game 1: O2 @ N3, Saturday, May 9 (loser out)
 - Games 2 & 3: Tues., May 12 @ approved site; (Winners to Gm5, losers to Gm4)
 - Games 4 & 5: Thur., May 14 @ D3 approved neutral site; (Winner game 4 = #1 seed, loser to game 6. Winner game 5 goes to game 6, loser out)
 - Game 6: Saturday, May 16 @ D3 approved neutral site; (Winner #2 seed, loser out)

Softball – The Olympic and Nisqually Leagues have combined into one league. Therefore, post-season representation will be based on the final league standings of the league schedule.

This tournament will be based on the agreed upon Modified double elimination tournament. The first round games (Game 1) will be single elimination. 2020 2 teams will qualify for state

- Format: Two Allocation WCD 1A Boys Bracket (Due to lack of NL/OL softball teams)

- Games 1-3 on Thursday, May 21 @ RAC in Lacey, WA
- Games 4-6 on Saturday, May 23 @ RAC in Lacey, WA

Girls Tennis – Tournament will be based on an eight entry double elimination tournament for both singles and doubles teams.

- The Nisqually League will send their top five singles and top five doubles teams.
- The Olympic League will send their top five singles and top three doubles teams.
- Date: May 20 - 21, 2020; two day tourney
 - Wednesday, May 20 – 3pm – 6:30pm
 - Thursday, May 21 - 8:00am – 6pm
- Site: Sprinker (Spanaway)
- \$25.00 per team will be charged to the school in which participants come from.

Track & Field – Two day meet: finals only.

- Date: May 22 - 23, 2020
- Site: North Mason HS

All events track and field are finals

Individual Events- Boys

- Nisqually (5 teams) = 4 automatic entries (Top four from league championships)
- Olympic (3 teams) = 2 automatic entries (Top two from league championships)
- The next 2 fastest times according to Athletic.net from the league championships
 - Times will be based on F.A.T. timing. NO hand timing will be accepted.

Relays

- Nisqually (5 teams) = 4 automatic entries (Top four in league)
- Olympic (3 teams) = 2 automatic entries (Top two in league)
- The 2 fastest times from the league championships will round out field.
 - Times will be based on F.A.T. timing. No hand timing will be accepted.

Individual Events- Girls

- Nisqually (6 teams) = 5 automatic entries (Top five from league championships)
- Olympic (3 teams) = 2 automatic entries (Top two from league championships)
- The next fastest time according to Athletic.net from the league championships
 - Times will be based on F.A.T. timing. NO hand timing will be accepted.

Relays

- Nisqually (6 teams) = 5 automatic entries (Top five in league)
- Olympic (3 teams) = 2 automatic entries (Top two in league)
- The fastest time from the league championships will round out field.
 - Times will be based on F.A.T. timing. No hand timing will be accepted.

If either the Nisqually or Olympic League can not fill their entries the other league can fill those spots to always try for an 8 entry final. The top two finishers for the boys will move on to state and the top 3 girls finishers will move on to state championships.

Boys Golf – An 18 hole tournament will be played on a date determined by the WCD3.


- 24 golfers will compete for the allotted allocation amount to the WIAA State Tournament.
 - Nisqually (5 teams) will qualify 15 golfers
 - Olympic (3 teams) will qualify 9 golfers


Girls Golf - An 18 hole tournament will be played on a date determined by the WCD3.

- 27 golfers will compete for the allotted allocation amount to the WIAA State Tournament.
 - Nisqually (6 teams) will qualify 18 golfers
 - Olympic (3 teams) will qualify 9 golfers

Each league will receive 3 entrants per qualifying team (5 members) and one additional District allocation for each team that does not meet the 5 member threshold.
